The Vaccaro family's Azienda Vitivinicola is situated in Western Sicily in Valle Belice. The community of Salaparuta, where the winery is located, got shaken by a huge earthquake in 1968. Only a little later, in 1970, Giacomo Vaccaro started to reconstruct his winery into how it looks today. Of course, as usual in Sicily, the whole family was helping him and therefore it is no wonder, that the winery is up to now a solely family run business.

Since the age of the Phoenicians, who then brought this art into Southern Italy, there is viticulture in Valle Belice. Surely, then the Phoenicians were following the criteria of ecological vine growing, and so do the Vaccaros in remembering the old, natural methods, adapting them with great passion and engagement.



Salaparuta lays in the upper part of Valle Belice with its chalky soil and own, specific micro climate. It is due to the local circumstances and the engagement of those few winemakers around the modern resurrected village, that a couple of years ago the designation of origin for the wines was defined: „DOP Salaparuta“ – finally.

The locals make wines without a lot of flourish; well done, straight forward and tasteful.

Essentially, the grapes are traditional ones, such as Nero D´Avola and the whites Catarratto and Grillo – wines, which simply represent earthiness.
