Family Sanz is well known in Spain, a country that loves wines. They are owning a big Bodega in the region of Rueda and co-owners of a couple of others in different regions. Over decades the Sanz where producing mostly excellent wines in different regions. But their origin is in the area around the little village of Rueda.

Rueda, about 200 km north east of Madrid, is the cradle of the Verdejo grape. Whereas this sort meanwhile is also cultivated in other areas, only here its aromas thrive in their purest form.

Similar to Sauvignon, Verdejo offers a touch of gooseberry, a stong touch of blackcurrant and more often than not a touch of woodruff and elderflower.
